# Chapter Spirit of Philanthropy Award

## **PURPOSE**

The Sigma Theta Tau International Foundation for Nursing presents the Chapter Spirit of Philanthropy Award to honor chapters (not individuals or a group of individual members) that have successfully implemented a project or group of projects involving noteworthy amounts of time, talents, and/or funds to non-society sponsored causes that advance the honor society's goals by contributing to the health and well-being of nurses, those served by nurses, and institutions contributing to improved care.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- All active chapters are eligible for this award. The award is for chapter activities covering the period from July 1, 2003, to March 1, 2005.
- A Chapter that received a previous Spirit of Philanthropy Award for a project is not eligible to submit the <u>same</u> project for a second award, even if the project is ongoing. Significant enhancements to a previously awarded project will be considered.

### **CRITERIA**

Philanthropic projects or groups of projects will be considered if they:

- 1. Exemplify and inspire the spirit of philanthropy, defined as "any voluntary effort to promote human welfare, be it through voluntary association or voluntary giving."
- 2. Portray a positive image of nursing.
- 3. Advance the society's mission of *developing leadership and* scholarship in practice, education and research to enhance the health of all people.
- 4. Enhance the health and welfare of others.
- 5. Are chapter-initiated (not individual member-driven) and involve participation by a significant number of chapter members.

A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Support documentation
