CRITERIA

- Honor Society of Nursing, Sigma Theta Tau International member.
- Demonstrated contributions of significance to health and welfare of children.
- Recognized nationally/internationally by others for contributions.
- Committed to ideals of the honor society.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- 500-700 word support summary that addresses criteria
- Letter of support
- Nominee's curriculum vitae
- Any other supporting material (not to exceed 10 pages) that provides direct evidence of nominee's contribution.
