



# Chapter Community Building Award

## PURPOSE

The Chapter Community Building Award recognizes chapters that have excelled in fostering a sense of community within their own chapters as well as beyond their chapter.

## ELIGIBILITY

All active chapters of the society are eligible.

## NOMINATIONS

Any chapter member or officer may nominate. Self-nominations are invited.

## CRITERIA

Chapter will be judged for the following qualities:

- Does the chapter bring diverse individuals together around a common focal point?
- Does the chapter create community in innovative ways that encourage the broadest possible participation?
- Is the chapter open and accountable to its stakeholders?
- Does the chapter structure themselves to create a fluid environment that can respond rapidly to change and/or opportunity?
- Does the chapter facilitate and encourage an ongoing dialogue to ensure that their communities remain relevant in a rapidly changing world?
- Does the chapter maintain both a broad, inclusive community as well as flexible, specialized niche communities?

## SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative that speaks to the related criteria (1-2 pages)
- Two letters of support from members who are not currently serving on the chapter board, addressing how the chapter meets the criteria
