The Pillar of Leadership award recognizes a recently inducted member whose leadership achievements have positively influenced programs or people.

ELIGIBILITY

All active members inducted between January 1, 2005 and December 31, 2006.

NOMINATIONS

Any member or chapter may nominate. Self-nominations are invited.

CRITERIA

The nominee will be judged for the following:

- Recent achievements that have supported future growth and success of the honor society, and the nursing profession accomplished through the nominee's ability to influencing outcomes and people
- Transforming change that has resulted from the nominee's influence on people, organizations or situations.
- An understanding of the self, and a knowledge of one's own potential and power
- A positive vision for leadership and a continuing commitment to leadership activities
- Knowledge, skills, and abilities related to personal, interpersonal, organizational, and civic/service leadership development
- · The ability to make connections with others in their community

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- One-to two page documentation of having fulfilled the criteria
- Two letters of support addressing how the new member meets the criteria
