CRITERIA

- The individual or group selected for this award has promoted innovative and creative uses of technology to further the goals of the nursing profession over a period of time.
- The results of these efforts have advanced knowledge building, synthesis, utilization, and dissemination of knowledge throughout the nursing profession or the general public.
- The outcomes reflect positively on the nursing profession.
- The outcomes have furthered the mission and goals of the Honor Society of Nursing, Sigma Theta Tau International

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Any supporting software or URL (If program is password protected, password must be included in order to evaluate. If time-limited password, allow for entire judging process.)
- A two-page, double-spaced summary describing the contributions that this group or individual has made including:
 - How the contribution/project has advanced knowledge building, synthesis, utilization, or dissemination of knowledge
 - How the contribution/project has affected the nursing profession as a whole and furthered the goals of the honor society
 - Support of the nomination including, but not limited to, published articles, books, letters of endorsement or reference, testimonials, and programs
