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Audrey Hepburn Award for Contributions to the Health and Welfare of Children

PURPOSE

The Audrey Hepburn Award for Contributions to the Health and Welfare of Children was established in 1993 to honor Ms. Hepburn's extraordinary work on behalf of children in need. This award is presented each biennium to a nurse who has made significant contributions to the health and well-being of children.

ELIGIBILITY

Nominee must be an active member of Sigma Theta Tau International (members may not self-nominate). STTI Board of Directors, STTI staff, STTI consultants and contracted staff, and members of the judging committee are not eligible.

CRITERIA

- Demonstrates significant contributions nationally/globally to health and welfare of children.
- Commits to mission and vision of STTI.
- Contributions may be in the areas of research, policy development, administration, evidence-based clinical practice, or education.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below must address the criteria. A complete online nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative (1-2 pages)
- Three (3) letters of support
- Nominee's curriculum vitae
- · Letter of acceptance
- Any other supporting documentation (not to exceed 10 pages)
