

Excellence in Creativity Award Edith Moore Copeland Founders Award

PURPOSE

The Founders Awards offer homage to the six founding nurses of Sigma and the director of nursing at Indiana University for their insights in 1922 that advanced scholarship, leadership, research, and practice. This award recognizes extraordinary excellence in creativity. *Sigma membership is required.*

All active members and chapters of Sigma are eligible to submit a nomination.

ELIGIBILITY

All active Sigma members worldwide are eligible to be nominated for this award. Members may not self-nominate; any self-nominations will be disqualified.

Current Sigma International Board of Directors, Sigma staff, Sigma consultants and contracted staff, and members of the judging committee are not eligible.

CRITERIA

Nomination should show evidence of meeting a majority of the following criteria:

- 1. Demonstrates creative activity to impact nursing education, practice, or research
- 2. Advances the knowledge base of nursing through creative activity
- 3. Impacts the image of nursing through creative activity
- 4. Disseminates results of creative activity
- 5. Fosters creativity in people such as colleagues, students, clients, and other healthcare providers
- 6. Receives recognition for creative activity

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below should address a majority the above criteria. Entries that do not meet the criteria and requirements below will be disqualified. A complete online nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative (1-2 pages)
- Two letters of support from diverse sources supporting the criteria (interprofessional colleague, supervisor, coworker, etc. excluding nominator)
- Nominee's curriculum vitae
- Letter of Acceptance Statement from the nominee agreeing to attend Sigma's Biennial Convention if selected

NOMINATION TIMELINE

1 November 2018 – 1 March 2019

ENTRY FEE:

US \$50

The fee structure for nominations outside the US is set according to World Bank classifications based on per-capita income designated as low, middle, and high.

NOTIFICATION

Award recipients will be notified in July 2019.

PRESENTATION

All awards will be presented at Sigma's <u>45th Biennial</u> <u>Convention</u> in Washington, DC, USA.
