

Hester C. Klopper Global Health Award

PURPOSE

The Hester C. Klopper Global Health Award recognizes Sigma chapters or institutions of higher learning or practice with active Sigma members engaged in undertaking projects that address global health disparities.

Any chapter member, officer, or program participant may nominate.

ELIGIBILITY

All active Sigma chapters – or institutions of higher learning or practice with Sigma members involved and engaged in programming – are eligible for this award. This award recognizes activities that were completed between 1 March 2017 and 1 March 2019.

CRITERIA

Nomination should show evidence of meeting a majority of the following criteria:

- 1. Has a sustained, positive impact on a global health disparity of a targeted population
- 2. Elevates the practice of nursing administration, education, leadership, policy, practice, or research
- 3. Advances the mission and vision of Sigma

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below should address a majority of the above criteria. Entries that do not meet the criteria and requirements below will be disqualified. A complete online nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative (1-2 pages)
- Letter of Acceptance Statement from a program representative agreeing to attend
 Sigma's Biennial Convention if selected
- Supporting documentation that demonstrates the criteria above (not to exceed 10 pages)

NOMINATION TIMELINE

1 November 2018 – 1 March 2019

ENTRY FEE:

US \$50

The fee structure for nominations outside the US is set according to World Bank classifications based on per-capita income designated as low, middle, and high.

NOTIFICATION

Award recipients will be notified in July 2019.

PRESENTATION

All awards will be presented at Sigma's 45th Biennial Convention in Washington, DC, USA.
