# Emerging Nurse Researcher Award

## PURPOSE

The purpose of the Honor Society of Nursing, Sigma Theta Tau International (STTI) Emerging Nurse Researcher Award is to recognize a nurse researcher from each of the global regions whose research has impacted the profession and the people it serves. **STTI membership is required.**

## ELIGIBILITY

All active STTI members worldwide are eligible to be nominated for this award (members may not self-nominate). STTI Board of Directors, STTI staff, STTI consultants and contracted staff, and members of the judging committee are not eligible.

## CRITERIA

1. Completed and earned a doctorate within in the last five years
2. Demonstrated that research has had an impact in a country or global region on the profession, patients, families, community, or policy
3. Demonstrated a record of disseminating research results in professional nursing and/or non-nursing publications and oral and/or poster presentations
4. Received external funding, university funding, or unique organizational support with justified unique context of funding as Principal Investigator (PI) or Co-PI
5. Recognized as an early career investigator and emerging leader whose work is influencing career practice, education, administration, research, and/or utilization of evidence

## SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below must address the criteria. A complete online nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative, using the five criteria as subheadings, that clearly describes area of emerging interest and scope (not exceeding 500 words)
- Three (3) letters of support from diverse sources supporting the criteria (interprofessional colleague, supervisor, coworker, etc. – excluding nominator)
- Nominee's curriculum vitae, plus a listing of three to five publications that showcases the criteria, including nursing and non-nursing peer-reviewed publications
- Letter of Acceptance - Statement from the nominee agreeing to attend STTI's International Nursing Research Congress if selected
- Supporting documentation as evidence of nominee's contribution as outlined in the five criteria above (not exceeding seven pages)
